Additional Notes:

- Art Education Candidacy Portfolio review required for admission into the BFA Art Education program. (<http://art.appstate.edu>)
- English and Reading proficiencies required.
- Admission to Teacher Education is required. To be admitted to the Teacher Education Program students must have a minimum of 2.7 cumulative GPA and take and satisfy testing requirements for Reading, Writing and Math areas of the Praxis (PPST or CBT).
- Graduation and licensure requires a 2.7 GPA.
- Residency Requirements:
 - 32 hours must be from ASU (25% of the credit hours required for the degree).
 - 18 hours in the major must be from ASU.
 - Final 30 hours must be courses taken through ASU (includes internships, study abroad taken through ASU).
