- 18 s.h. in major and 9 s.h. in minor must be at ASU.
- 50 s.h. must be earned from a Senior Institution and 25% of the degree hours must be in residency at ASU
- As stated in the catalog, the final responsibility for meeting graduation requirements remains with the student.
- Minimum Admission Requirements: 45 semester hours completed (12 of these at ASU or with program director permission) with a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.2 and completion of prerequisite courses with a minimum grade of B or 3.0 in each.
- Prerequisite Courses: A minimum grade of B or 3.0 in each of the following courses (transfer equivalency will be accepted, including AP or University Placement): CSD 2259, CSD 2260 and three semester hours of the general education science inquiry perspective requirement
- Students may repeat a CSD course only once. Students may repeat only two CSD courses throughout the program.
