- **Restrictions on 3000/4000 level business courses continued:**

Students must have 45 hours and a declared SCM major OR 54 hours to take SCM 3650.

Students must have 54 hours to take any other 3000 level business course.

Students must have 84 hours and a minimum grade of "C" in a WID course prior to taking any 4000 level business course.

- *The following course work must be taken through ASU: the last 30 hours, 50% of all business course work required in the major, 9 hours of any minor. A minimum of 50 hours must be taken through a four year institution.*
