**Additional Notes**

- A contract with a list of the approved Computer Programming & Application Courses MUST be filed with the College of Arts & Sciences Dean’s Office no later than the end of the first semester of junior year.
- Residency Requirements:
  - 31 hours must be from ASU
  - 18 hours in the major must be from ASU
  - 9 hours in the minor must be from ASU
  - Final 30 hours must be courses taken through ASU (includes internships, study abroad taken through ASU)
