- *The foreign language should be selected early. Students must either pursue a language for which ASU offers a minor or another language approved by the IB program coordinator and the foreign language advisor.*
- *^Students who do not place out of any level of foreign language should begin the foreign language prerequisites (1010, 1020, 1040, 1050) in the first semester. The foreign language placement test for French, German and Spanish is available online through the Department of Language, Literature and Culture. For other languages, contact the Department of Language, Literature and Culture for advice regarding placement.*
- x *Students who are not prepared to begin the courses for the language minor/concentration must take up to 12 sh of beginning and intermediate language courses. Of these, three hours (1050 or 3 sh of 1060) can cover a Liberal Studies Experience course in the Gen Ed and six hours can cover free electives.*
