Additional Notes:

- Sociology electives and concentration courses should be chosen in consultation with the student's Sociology advisor.
- All students must have an Internship Proposal approved by the Internship Proposal Committee the semester (fall, spring) prior to enrolling in their Internship (SOC 4900).
- <u>Residency Requirements</u>:
 - o 31 hours must be from ASU
 - 18 hours in the major must be from ASU
 - o 9 hours in the minor must be from ASU
 - Final 30 hours must be courses taken through ASU (includes internships, study abroad taken through ASU)
